Makharij

3. How you will determine the makhraj?

First place a sukun over the letter whose makhraj to be determined. Then, prefix it when an alif bearing a Fatha -----, Read it.

4. Find out Makharij of these letters. Ba, Da'l, K.a'f, Ta'a.-----.

5. Complete the sentence.

It is sufficient to know that an alif becomes a hamza when a fatha, damma or Kasra is placed over it.

6. When "alif bears no harakats, it is simply called an "alif.

7. What is an alif maqsoorah?

When the alif is written over a letter, it is called alif maqsoorah.

8. How many domains of Makharij are there in Tajweed? Five.

10. What are the Maddah letters?

Alif, waw and Ya.

Alif is sakin and preceded by Fatha.

Waw is sakin and preceded by damma.

Ya is sakin and preceded by Kasra.

11. What 's the other name of Maddah letters?

Oral cavity.

12. Where they Pronounce from?

They are pronounced from the hollow portion of the mouth.

13. How long we can stretch them?

Maddah letters are actually stretched to 2 harakats.

14. What are the Guttural letters ?

Letters which are pronounced from the throat are called guttural letters, throat letters.

15. What are the other names of Guttural letters?

Huruf al -halaq.

16. How many guttural letters are there?

There are six guttural letters.

17. Which one are those?

18. How many Makharij located in 3 different regions of the throat?

Aqsa, awsat, and adna.

19. Which parts of the throat called aqsa?

It is lower part of the throat.

20. Which letters can be pronounced from this area?

21. Which part of the throat called Awsat?

It is the middle part of the throat.

22. Which letters pronounced from this area?

23. Which one is the front part of the throat?

Adna.

24. Which two letters pronounced from this part?

25. Write down any five Arabic letters which are pronounced from tongue area?

Waw, mim, ba and fa.

27. What's the other name of lip letters?

Shafawi letters.

Nasal cavity.

30. Which condition can we find in Gunnah letters?

Gunnah is observed under the following condition.
