### Written Exam:

1. Salat is the 2<sup>nd</sup> pillar of Islam
2. Salat is a command of Allah
3. Prayer reminds us of Allah
4. All men and women are Allah's servants and prayer helps remove feelings of pride and superiority towards other people
5. Muslims should pray in groups because it increased the feeling of brotherhood among Muslims
6. Children should pray from the age of 7 and can be punished at the age of 10
7. Prayer teaches us 3 main things:
  - Punctuality
  - Cooperation
  - Discipline
8. The purpose of Salat is to remember and praise Allah and thank Allah for his blessing
9. Muslims must pray 5 times a day
10. There are 4 kinds of Salat
  - Fard ( compulsory prayer)
  - Wajjib (compulsory but not as important as Fard)
  - Sunnah (recommended by the prophet)
  - Nafil ( not compulsory)
11. The 5 prayers are
  - Fajr (Dawn to sunrise)
  - Zuhr (mid-day to mid-afternoon)
  - Asr (afternoon to before sunset)
  - Maghrib (after sunset)
  - Isha (disappearance of sunlight, 1/3 into the night)
12. The call to prayer is called Adhan
13. The call to start prayer is called Iqamah
14. The direction of the Kabah is called the Qiblah
