1. Isra and Miraj (Study from the quiz)

What does Lailatul Miraj mean? Night of Ascent

The two parts of Lailatul Miraj are...

1. Isra- The Prophet journeyed from Mecca to Jerusalem on a winged animal called the buraq. He met the other prophets and led them in prayer
2. Miraj- The prophet ascended to the heavens where he received the gift of prayers from Allah (swt)

What mosque is in...

Mecca?.....Masjid Al-Haram

Madinah?..... Masjid An-Nabawi

Jerusalem?..... Masjid Al-Aqsa

2. Lailat ul Qadr

What does Lailat ul Qadr mean? The Night of Power

What happened on this night? The ayahs of the Quran were revealed to the prophet for the first time.

When does this night happen? No one knows for sure, but we know that it happens on one of the odd nights in the last ten days of Ramadan (21st, 23rd, 25th, 27th, 29th)

What should we do on this night? We should make prayer and dua

3. Wuddu and Tayammum

When are you allowed to perform Tayammum?

- When water is unavailable or scarce
- Water is harmful for medical reasons
- Available water is very dirty

How do you perform Taymum?

1. Make intention
2. Rub both hands on clean soil, sand, or stone
3. Wipe face with hands
4. Wipe both arms with the hands

How do you perform Wudhu? (On the test, you will have to number them in order)

1. Say Bismillah
2. Make intention
3. Wash hands three times up to wrists (right hand)
4. Gargle mouth three times (right hand)
5. Rinse nose three times (left hand)
6. Wash entire face three times

7. Wash arms up to elbows three times
8. Do Masah (wipe head, ears and back of neck)
9. Wash feet up to ankle three times

4. Fard, Sunnah, and Nafl

What is the difference between the three?

Fard: You MUST pray these prayers

Sunnah: These prayers are strongly recommended

Nafl: These prayers are completely optional but highly beneficial

5. Hajj Rites

Who has to perform Hajj?

Everyone who is physically and financially able to.

What do men wear on Hajj?

Sheets of unsown cloths, usually white, wrapped around the body

What do women wear on Hajj?

Ordinary, modest clothes, very plain

When we spend a day in Arafat, what should we do?

Make dua and pray all day long

What do you do in Rami?

pilgrims throw pebbles at three different walls, representing the places Shaitan came to tempt Prophet Ibrahim to not follow Allah (swt)

What is Tawaf?

When you circle the Kabbah seven times

What is a reward of Hajj?

After completing it, you go home forgiven of all sins, like a newborn baby

6. Salatul Jummah

When does Salatul Jummah occur?

On Fridays, at Zuhr Time

When Muslims arrive at the mosque, what does the Imam do?

He delivers a Khutbah, a speech about the teachings of Islam

After the Khutbah, what happens?

The Imam leads the muslims in two rakats of Fard Prayer
